17th April - Maundy Thursday Passover Meal

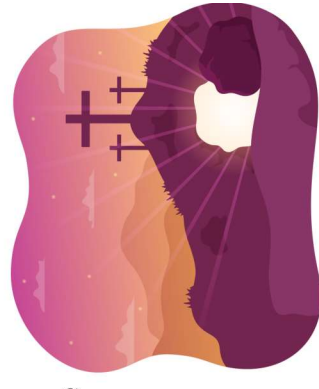

Café open - Sunday 30th March

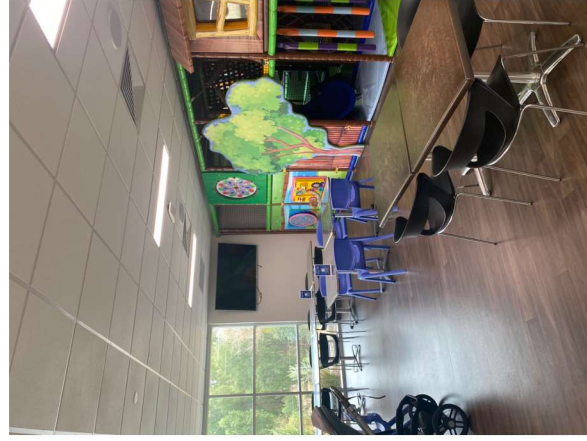
