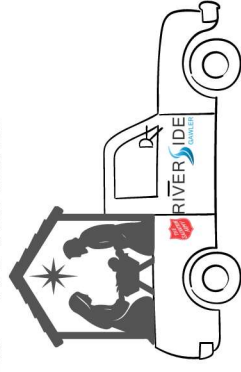

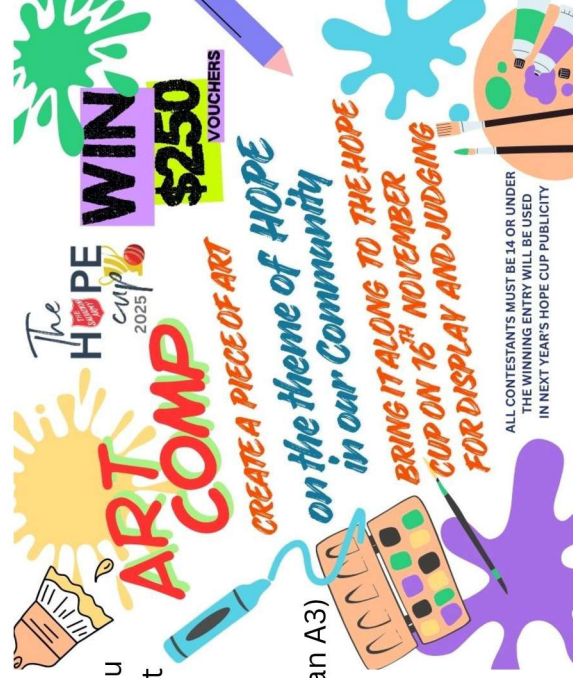
Gawler Hot Bread Bakery - Red and Blue Donuts

This week at Riverside we celebrated six people being baptised, thirteen people being made members, two people transferring from another Salvation Army Church and two more being affirmed in their soldiership and adherence. Over the course of our Sunday services you would have heard many talk of their reasons for taking the step they have taken. We call this a testimony and it is an important part of Christian faith and practice. It's the ability to share with others your spiritual experiences and convictions.

Q1. If you were at church on Sunday what word of testimony really impacted you and why?

Q2. Why is giving your testimony so important? What benefit is it to you and to those around you?

Read 1 Peter 3:15 and Psalm 96:1-3

Q3. If someone asked you to tell them about *your* hope in Christ what would you tell them? What would your testimony be?

Q4. Psalm 96 talks about a new song being sung, day after day. It points to a freshness of experience in God and his goodness on a daily basis.

Q5. Share with the group an experience of God - answered prayer, Bible devotion, the spirit's leading, a moment of worship and wonder from the last two weeks. Practice sharing you authentic, up to date testimony of Christ in your life with each other. It will bless you and them.

People need to hear your story! It is the most powerful thing you can offer them!



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
