Jonah Part 2 (Jonah 1:17 - Jonah 2)

- Q1. Where do you like to watch lightning storms from? Do you even like to spectate or are you hiding under the covers?
- Q2. What do you understand by the phrase “I’m experiencing a storm in my life”? What does that word picture describe for you?
- Q3. Sometimes we find ourselves in ‘storms of life’ that have no rational explanation. Can you share any storms that have hit you or your family out of the blue?
- Q4. Have you experienced ‘storms’ that someone you know has created for you?
- Q5. Have you experienced ‘storms’ that you have created yourself? How did that blow up?

Read Jonah 1:17 - Jonah 2 and discuss the scripture.

- Q6. What do we learn from Jonah in this situation? What does Jonah’s story teach us about God and can you relate to Jonah in any way?

Compare these readings with Mark 4:35-41

- Q7. What are the similarities and contrasts between Jonah and Jesus?

Read Matthew 12:38-42

- Q8. What does this tell us about Jesus?
- Q9. How is Jesus the true hope amongst the storms of life?
- Q10. What will you take away from this study today?
