Q1. If you could describe the Gospel message in a few sentences, what would you say?

Q2. What does a church that encourages one another look like to you?

Read Acts 2:36-47

Q3. What does this tell us about God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit?

Q4. What does it tell us about people?

Q5. What is this calling us to do and how are we going to do it?

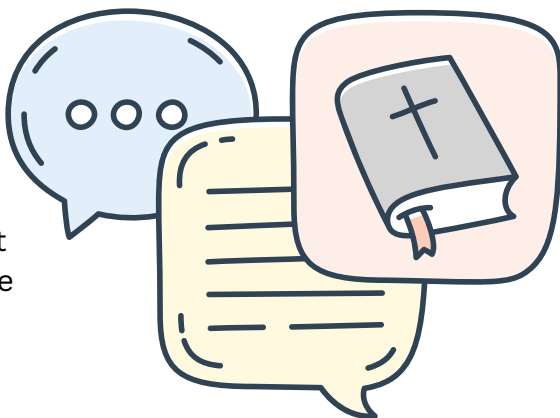
Q6. What is it that Jesus has done for you that sets your heart to worship him and share about him?

Q7. What do you devote your life to?

Q8. In verse 42 the early church devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. What do you feel God wants you to be devoted to?

Q9. What does it look like to be invested in your church family not only on Sunday, but every day?

Q10. How do you keep your heart in a place where you are attentive to the work of the Holy Spirit?



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Read Luke 22:54-62 & Acts 2:36-47

Q1. Compare and contrast Peter in these two passages. What has changed, these two event are only 50 days apart?

Q2. Peter, who couldn't cope with questions from a servant girl, is able to stand and preach to thousands. This is the power of the Holy Spirit at work in him. However, how is the Holy Spirit at work in the crowds?

Q3. The people say to Peter "What should we **do**"? Why is that question the right question?

Q4. Peter says firstly, "repent of your sins". What does the word repent mean for you? How do you actually repent and why is this an action as opposed to an emotion (ie *just feeling sorry*)?

Q5. Peter says be baptised for the forgiveness of your sins. Why is this so important and why do you think they baptised people who repented on the very same day, all 3000 of them? (read verse 41).

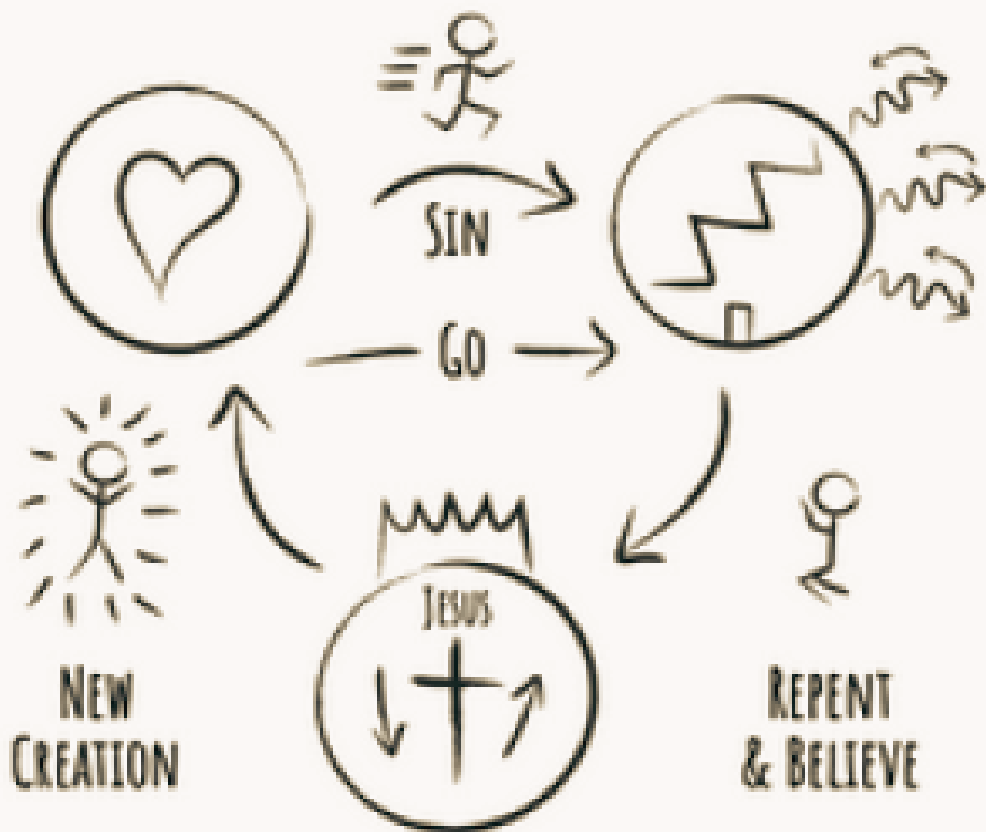
Q6. Peter then says then you will receive the gift of the promised Holy Spirit. (Again it seems he expected this to happen on the same day they repented and were baptised). What implications does this have for anyone who comes to Jesus at Riverside?

Q7. Darren said repenting, being forgiven, being baptised and receiving the Holy Spirit were crucial elements in the discipleship journey of the early church into healing, relationship and purpose. Is it the same for our generation today? *If your discussions raise any questions about this let your Life Group leader know and Darren will deal with them in future teaching.*

Activity: In you Life Groups practice sharing the Gospel message in the simple way Darren did on Sunday. (its included overleaf) Then pray for opportunities to use it.
