Sweet Aroma

1. Discuss what you now know about onions.
2. **Read Genesis 8:20-22.** What happened as a result of Noah sacrificing to the Lord?
3. Exodus 29 describes the dedication ceremony for the Jewish priests. Three times, sacrifices are described as producing a pleasing aroma to God. 35 times in Leviticus and Numbers, sacrifices are described as producing a pleasing aroma to God. What is the result of these sweet-smelling sacrifices, from **Exodus 29:42-46**?
4. Read **Jeremiah 6:16-21** and **Isaiah 65:1-5**. What actions and attitudes make our lives stink before God? What is God challenging you about from these passages?
5. **Read John 12:1-8.** Who do you identify with from this passage? Is there something that needs to be broken or given in your life, so that your life smells fragrant to God?
6. **Read 2 Corinthians 2:14-16 and Ephesians 5:2.** Discuss what you know about how Jesus' life was a sweet smelling aroma to God. Share testimonies of how your life has been a fragrant aroma of Christ in the past week, or pray for God to use your life in this way to point others to Christ.

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
