Read Ephesians 5:10-12

- Q1. Paul instructs us in Ephesians 5:15 to be careful how we live? What is the craziest risk you have ever taken, and how did it end up?.
- Q2. Paul says that if we take risks with our behaviour, most pertinently by not being in control of our anger, we give the devil a foothold. What do think Paul means by this?
- Q3. In his sermon Darren said there is such a thing as righteous anger but only God is righteous enough to handle it. What do you think Darren meant by this?
- Q4. All the negative behaviours outlined in Ephesians 4:17-32 and 5:1-13 impact relationships. Go through each one in turn and discuss what consequences each have in the body of Christ (the church).
- In Ephesians 5:16 Paul says we are living in evil days. Another way of translating this is that 'days are our enemy'. They pass by so quickly and as we get older the just seem to accelerate. Paul tells us to take every opportunity to live well for Christ because if we continue in our bad behaviour precious time for evangelism, service and ministry etc. will be tied up with regrets, hurt, healing and recovery and that takes time.
- Q5. Paul tells us not to be thoughtless in verse 17. Being thoughtless means we are living life on our instincts and appetites. It is only when we start to carefully consider our behaviour that we can rise above our basic urges and live for Jesus. How thoughtless are you about how you live?
- Q6. If one part of the body is rejoicing the whole body of Christ rejoices, if one part is hurting the whole body of Christ hurts too. If one part of the body of Christ is sinning the light and warmth of the whole body is diminished and cast into shade. Do you believe this and if so how careful are you living your life?
