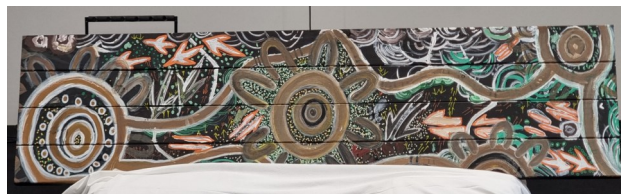
Gawler Christmas Parade
