# **Spiritual Infants**

Q1. What is your first response when confronted with a new born baby? Are you enchanted and want a cuddle or do you recoil and keep a distance? Explain why?

#### Read 1 Peter 2:2

- Why do you think Peter uses the word 'crave' in this passage, what is he trying to express?
- Peter also talks about 'pure' spiritual milk, why does he mention the quality of the milk? What would happen spiritually if the milk was not completely pure?

#### Read Corinthians 3:1

What do you think about Paul saying that Christians can still be controlled by their sinful nature? What does he imply will overcome this?

If we have the joy of parenting an infant human, there are several key developmental markers that medical people look for to see if the child is progressing and growing healthily. It is the same with spiritual babies.

- Q5. In his Sermon Darren talked about a spiritual infant finding their voice, what do you think this relates to, and why is this important?
- Darren also talked about a spiritual infant becoming aware of their identity. Why is this crucial for normal spiritual growth?

Finally Darren said a spiritual infant has to be able to show an understanding of their own story and where they fit in God's story. Knowing your own story and where you belong gives a sense of security, acceptance and significance as well as promoting resilience.

Q7. Take some time to reflect on your own identity, do you know who you are in Christ and do you know and believe what Father God says about you? Have you developed a voice to pray, worship, confess and share honestly what is going on inside yourself? Can you share your story and how Jesus is part of it? Share you reflections and take time to pray for each other.
