Purruna Community Garden Grant

Riverside has been successful in their recent grant application to the Thriving Regions Fund - Thriving Communities Program. The Purruna Community Garden project has been awarded \$47,687 to support the projects at the back of our property.

This includes creating disability access paths to the bush kitchen shed and vegetable garden, play equipment for children, a yarnning circle for community groups and plants for revegetation. This project supports multiple groups during the week. The Purruna Community Garden group will be able to create more wicking beds and those who struggle with mobility will now be able to access this area. The OT group on Fridays can now offer the veranda area and vegetable garden to their clients who have mobility challenges; and the Bush School will increase the cultural safety and teaching opportunity in our space by having a yarnning circle, including a fire pit for cooking.

This grant could not have been won without the tireless efforts of Rick and Mandy Mierich. Rick and Mandy oversee grounds at Riverside and spent time developing the proposal for this grant. They also have a passion for connecting people to Jesus through His nature and the garden.

Purruna Community Garden group meets Tuesday fortnightly at 10am. It starts with a devotion, prayer and a cup of tea, then the group spends time working on projects around the property. Rick and Mandy continue to see new faces come into the group and people who are not connected to our Church.
