

Sermon by Darren Dwyer Available on App and Website



- Q1. What was the most important thing you learnt when you were a child?
- Q2. Who was your favourite teacher and why?
- Q3. Why is 'teaching' so important in the early life of a Christian the spiritual child phase.
- Q4. Darren said in his sermon that we should be instructed in not just knowing about Jesus but knowing Jesus. Why is this so important?
- Q5. As we grow as spiritual children our focus must be on Jesus and his commands, he spent three years with his disciples so this is not a phase of growth that needs to be rushed. How much time do you spend getting to know and learn directly from Jesus? How do you do this? Is anyone teaching you how to do this?

Darren spoke about five questions that should become the framework of a disciples approach to living successfully as a follower of Jesus. Whatever situation you face, answering these five questions will give you the foundations of a response and an action. - 1) Who is God? 2) What has he done most fully in Christ? 3) Who are we? 4) What do we do? 5) How do we do it?

- Q6. Share some situations that you are facing at the moment at work or within your family and as a group answer those 5 questions together to discern what God might be saying about this situation and what he might require you to do? (This is just an exercise and all such situations will need prayer, listening to the spirit and wise council). It will be most helpful for those who see themselves as spiritual children and have not yet learned this way to approach life.
- Q7. Darren used the phrase 'Discern and Do' and said it was the clearest sign of spiritual maturity. What do you make of his statement? Are their other ways to be spiritually mature?
- Q8. Where do you see yourself on the spiritual growth chart—newborn, infant, child, adult?
 What is your next step?
