WOW Ladies meeting - Cancelled for August

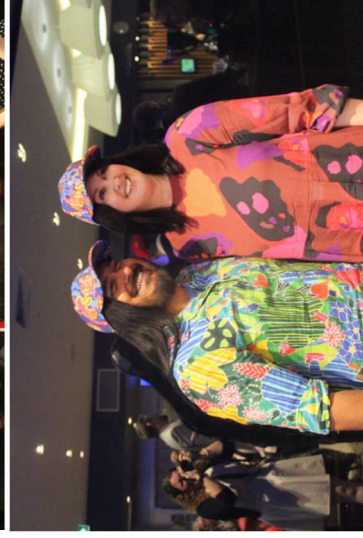
